If you were sent a notification in December 2020 that a Mercy employee improperly accessed your or your minor child's protected health information and/or personally identifiable information (the "Incident"), you could get benefits from a class action settlement.

You were previously sent a Notice that contains information about a proposed class action Settlement with Defendant. More information can be found at www.mercysettlement.com or by calling toll-free at 1-800-935.5170. Your rights may be affected whether you act or not.

What are my options? You can file a claim to receive Settlement benefits, do nothing and stay in the case, exclude yourself, or object to the Settlement. The deadline to take action is June 10, 2024. If you do not exclude yourself, and the Court approves the Settlement, you will be bound by the Court's orders and judgments, even if you do not file a claim.

How do I file a claim? You will be considered a member of the Settlement Class unless you timely file a Valid Exclusion Statement. Class Members may submit a claim online at www.mercysettlement.com, via mail to Claims Administrator, Mercy Health Settlement c/o Atticus Administration, PO Box 64053, Saint Paul, MN 55164 or e-mailed to the Claims Administrator at mercysettlement@atticusadmin.com by June 10, 2024.

What happens next? The Court will hold a Final Approval Hearing on June 18, 2024, to decide whether the Settlement is fair, reasonable, and adequate. You or your attorney may ask permission to speak at the hearing at your own cost.
